The Masters of Social Work program at the University of Maryland School of Social Work is accredited by Council on Social Work Education for preparing students for a degree in social work. The MSW program satisfies the educational requirements for graduates to apply for the Association of Social Work Boards exam which is one requirement for licensure as a Licensed Master Social Worker (LMSW) in Maryland. The School has not made a determination as to the sufficiency of its program to satisfy professional licensing requirements of any other state or jurisdiction. Each licensing authority sets and enforces its own professional licensing requirements and standards. Each student should inquire directly to the licensing authority in the jurisdiction where the student plans to seek licensure in order to determine the mandatory requirements to be licensed to practice.
