PURPOSE: Standards for delivering case management services across the central Maryland region vary and are inconsistent in both quality and frequency. United Way of Central Maryland and University of Maryland School of Social Work have created a case management certificate training program which will provide case managers with the skills they need to be effective in helping individuals and families alleviate crisis and move towards self-sufficiency.

GOAL: The goal of the program is to standardize the delivery of case management services across our region to increase service provider capacity which will ultimately result in higher program outcomes for clients being served.

A cohort of 35 case managers will participate in a 9-month program that includes monthly workshops, ongoing testing to ensure skills are being learned and a capstone final exam at the end. Participants who attend all required sessions and pass the final exam with a satisfactory score will be eligible to receive the certificate.

The University of Maryland School of Social Work Office of Continuing Professional Education and United Way of Central Maryland are authorized by the Board of Social Work Examiners in Maryland to sponsor social work continuing education programs and maintains full responsibility for this program. This program qualifies for 50 Category 1 Continuing Education Units (CEUs). Successful completion of this activity requires your signature on the sign-in sheet, participation in the entire activity, and completion of an evaluation form.
