

## **Motivational Interviewing (MI) Certificate Program**

**Application Due: July 29, 2019**

Instructor: Mary Hodorowicz, LCSW-C

This certificate program was designed to provide MI knowledge attainment and skill acquisition. Participants will be learn resources and information necessary for gaining MI knowledge through course content, while also having the opportunity for practice and actual MI skill improvement. This will be accomplished through experiential learning activities, feedback and coaching. The structure of the course was created with the working professional in mind, containing a combination of in-person and online classes using a variety of teaching methods including lecture, visual aids, hands on practice exercises, and discussion.

MI consistent skills of participants will be evaluated prior to the first class and then again after course completion\*, so participants will have a measure of their MI skill development from start to finish. With content covering topics from Core Concepts to Managing the “Mandated Client”, this program is appropriate for social workers with a range of prior MI knowledge and experience. Additionally, with sessions on ethics, supervision, and leadership, this program contains information relevant to social workers in direct practice or administration and management. To maximize individualized feedback and coaching opportunities, space is limited to 30 participants and only those enrolled in the program will be permitted to participate in the sessions.

\*MI Skill evaluation via a simulated client interaction will occur both before and after the program. Participation in the simulated client interaction is part of the MI continuing education program. Program completion is only possible through completion of the pre and post skill evaluation. The MI simulated client interaction dates are indicated below, both before and after course training dates. The MI interaction will require signing up for a thirty minute block of time on one of the indicated dates. The simulation will occur remotely over the phone or via your computer, whichever mode is most comfortable and convenient for you.
