**Donald W. Burnes, PhD**, is the founder of The Burnes Center on Poverty and Homelessness at the Graduate School of Social Work, University of Denver, where he is also an Adjunct Professor and a Scholar in Residence. He is currently working there on a webinar series on how to address rural homelessness. A local philanthropist concerned with the issues of homelessness and housing, he served on the Colorado State Interagency Advisory Group on Homelessness and has been a member of Denver's Road Home Advisory Commission and the Colorado Housing and Homelessness Funders Collaborative. He is also part of the strategic planning group for a major homelessness initiative from Unilever, a major multi-national corporation. He is currently working on his fourth book, *The Invisible Disaster: Homelessness in America*. Dr. Burnes received his BA from Princeton, his MAT from Washington University in St. Louis, and his PhD in education from Columbia University.

**The Homelessness Social Work Council** is dedicated to ending homelessness, one of the twelve Grand Challenges of Social Work. The Council was formed by the University of Maryland School of Social Work for the purpose of expanding partnerships and student internships with agencies in the community that serve the homeless; integrating content on the issues facing the homeless into the MSW curriculum; and thus preparing a workforce dedicated to serving the homeless population. The Council's goals are to collect data and track trends, investigate causes, advance solutions, and to expand collaborations in the region to increase awareness and develop partnerships.
